


Santa's Sleigh - Rotary Club (


College Volunteering Christmas Card Appeal DO's and DON'TS

'00's

- Address the card to 'Dear Friend' for example, as you will not know their name.
- Say a little about yourself, where you are from, what you are studying, family, interests, and hobbies.
- Wish them a very Merry Christmas.
- Try to write clearly and legibly (if your handwriting is difficult to read perhaps include a printed copy).
- Write as many as you like, there is no limit to the number you can send.
- Get creative you could send a picture you've drawn/painted or something you've made, but please don't send any photographs of yourself.
- Remember that you are representing your college and university.
- Post your cards by the 10th of December.

DON'TS

- Seal the envelope, the care homes like to be able to choose the recipient who will most enjoy your card.
- Provide any personal details (address, phone number, surname etc.), just your first name.
